

HARRY PHILLIPS

Harry was a player for Richmond Presbyterian 1931-40, enlisted in the AIF and then returned after the war to Toorak Presbyterian for three successive premierships. He was captain-coach of the Presbyterian Association team for twelve years and then coach for three years of a very successful Victorian state team. From 1933 to the 1950s he was Secretary or President of PMBA. Harry was awarded life membership in 1950 and in his later years turned to refereeing in which he had distinctions such as refereeing at the Australian Women's Championships.
