Do I need to attend the Pre-Trial?

You must attend the pre-trial if:

- You are currently a domestic-only player, or
- You are a player transferring from another club

Please note: The pre-trial is only for U14, U16 & U18 Boys age groups.

- Players trialling for the U12 age group will begin trials on Sunday 5th October.
- If you are a current Eltham Wildcats VJBL Player, you do not need to attend pretrials.

What is the trial process?

• The process is as follows: Each week of the trials, players participate in two separate sessions as follows:

Sunday Sessions – Sundays are a "on court drill-based session". Players are organised into smaller, more manageable groups (named colours... Blue group, green group, orange group etc etc) and put through skills and small game sessions by trial coaches.

Weekday Sessions (Friday)— Weekdays are for "trial games". Players are assigned "trial game" squads and play trial games generally Thursday night or Friday night, however the allocated night for these games may change each week for each age group and it could be any weeknight. Players will be notified prior to the day.

What if I can't make a trial session?

Can I watch trials as a parent/ Guardian?

- Parents/Guardians are permitted in the stadium to watch the trial games on weekdays (Friday nights)
- While players are in session Parents/Guardians <u>are not</u> permitted on the courts to watch the trials on Sundays but can watch from the foyers at the respective venue.

What to bring to trial sessions?

- Basketball (please have name and number written on the ball)
- Water bottle
- Any necessary tape or brace

If I get selected into a team, how much are the fees?

Fee	Amount
Acceptance Fee (non-refundable)	\$100

Second Instalment (April)	\$335 (1 session/week) or \$435 (2 sessions/week)

^{*}These fees do not include mandatory uniform (Shorts, Singlet & Warm up top)

How will you be notified of trial updates?

• The updates will be through this notice board and will be updated after every session or via email. Once registered for trials you will also get an email notification for every noticeboard update.

What do I wear to trials?

• Please wear your Eltham uniform (domestic or championship) to this session. If you don't have an Eltham uniform, please wear a light/dark reversible top.

What age group is my child in?

- Players are 'grouped' depending upon age. Age groupings are as follows for 2025/26 season
 - Under 12's (Born 2015, 2016 and 2017)
 - Under 14's (Born 2013 and 2014)
 - Under 16's (Born 2011 and 2012)
 - Under 18's (Born 2009 and 2010)
 - Under 20's (Born 2007 and 2008)

What if I'm coming from another club/How does the Transfer process work?

- Players who are currently playing for or have previously played in a VJBL competition and
 wish to obtain 'Permission to train' (PTT) at another association must complete and submit
 the correct form before trying out with a new association. Associations have 5 business days
 to approve the request.
