### **What happens if there is a clash of singlet numbers? Who swaps?**

If there are two players who have the same number (highlighted in yellow on the team lists)

In accordance with our club directive, In the event of a number clash within a team, the player who has played for **Eltham Wildcats Basketball Club** the **longest** has the option to either:

1. Retain their number  
or
2. Change to a different one

Once the decision has been made, the player that is changing numbers will need to bring their singlet to the admin office at **Montmorency Secondary College (Basketball Stadium – Upstairs – Level 1)** and we will find the appropriate size and number. Once the season is completed you can return the 'Swap Top' and we will return the players original singlet.

### Can I get my own fill- in Players?

Yes, please refer to the EDJBA matrix below to ensure that the player you are seeking to Fill In is eligible to play. If the player is found to be ineligible the game could face a forfeit.

- <b>Same or Younger</b> age group	Section A	Section B,C,D or E
Player from a <b>Section C team</b> can "fill in" for:		
- <b>Older</b> age group	Section A, B, C or D	Section E
- <b>Same or Younger</b> age group	Section A OR b	Section C,D or E
Player from a <b>Section D team</b> can "fill in" for:		
- <b>Older</b> age group	Section A, B, C, D or E	NA
- <b>Same or Younger</b> age group	Section A, B, OR C	Section D or E

### Is there Fill in player process the same for finals?

No, during finals there is a different system, whereby we must submit requests to the EDJBA.

Further information on this will be communiated closer to finals.

### When is the deadline for requesting a fill in player?

Please ensure to get your request in as early as possible before your game. Preferably before Thursday afternoon prior to your game. This will allow our Wildcats Support Staff enough time to find players and contact you whether a fill-in has been found or not.
